## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Memorializing Congress to review the current foreclosure
- 2 practice of the Farmers Home Administration.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Farmers Home Administration was created to
- 4 assist low-income rural residents towards purchasing homes; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The FHA has in Pennsylvania and in other states
- 6 implemented foreclosure practices that appear to be more
- 7 restrictive than local lending institutions; and
- 8 WHEREAS, This policy has resulted in mortgage foreclosures of
- 9 homeowners who are disabled, unemployed or underemployed through
- 10 no fault of their own and in many instances these homeowners are
- 11 continuing to make payments towards principal and/or interest;
- 12 and
- WHEREAS, This practice appears to be in contradiction to the
- 14 original intent of the FHA; therefore be it
- 15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives memorialize the
- 16 United States Congress to review the current foreclosure
- 17 practice of the Farmers Home Mortgage Administration; and be it
