5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 1202 of the act of February 1, 1966 (1965
8	P.L.1656, No.581), known as The Borough Code, is amended by
9	adding a clause to read:
10	Section 1202. Specific PowersThe powers of the borough
11	shall be vested in the corporate authorities. Among the specific
12	powers of the borough shall be the following, and in the
13	exercise of any of such powers involving the enactment of any
14	ordinance or the making of any regulation, restriction or
15	prohibition, the borough may provide for the enforcement thereof
16	and may prescribe penalties for the violation thereof or for the
17	failure to conform thereto:

18 * * *

1	(79) Appropriation for support of drug and alcohol programs.
2	To appropriate annually out of general funds of the borough a
3	sum not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000) to be divided
4	in amounts as the borough council deems proper to be used for
5	education and the development of programs within the community
6	dealing with drug and alcohol abuse. These funds may be
7	contributed to existing programs in adjacent communities or in
8	the county where the borough is situate at the discretion of the
9	borough council.

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
