AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for the use of lighted lamps.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Section 4302 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

7 § 4302. Period for requiring lighted lamps.

8 Every vehicle upon a highway at any time between sunset and
9 sunrise, at any time when identification, clearance or side-
10 marker lights are utilized and at any other time when, due to
11 insufficient light or unfavorable atmospheric conditions,
12 persons and vehicles on the highway are not clearly discernible
13 from a distance of 1000 feet ahead shall display lighted head
14 and other lamps and illuminating devices as required under this
15 chapter for different classes of vehicles, subject to exceptions
16 with respect to parked vehicles. Stop lights, turn signals and
17 other signaling devices shall be lighted as prescribed in this

1 title.

2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
