AN ACT

- Providing for the adoption of capital projects to be financed from current revenues of the Game Fund.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Game Fund
- Capital Budget Act for 1984-1985.
- 8 Section 2. Total authorization.
- (a) Subject to the limitations set forth in subsection (b), 9
- 10 the total authorization for the capital projects in the category
- of public improvement projects to be acquired by the 11
- Pennsylvania Game Commission and to be financed from current 12
- 13 revenues of the Game Fund pursuant to executive authorizations
- shall be \$4,839,267. 14
- 15 (b) Notwithstanding the total authorization in subsection
- (a), the total executive authorizations for fiscal year 1984-16

- 1 1985 for the capital projects itemized in section 3 shall not
- 2 exceed \$3,000,000, which sum contains the amount of \$944,634,
- 3 which is one-third of the purchase price for the Blair County
- 4 tract, the remaining two-thirds of the price to be paid in
- 5 fiscal years 1985-1986 and 1986-1987.
- 6 Section 3. Itemization of capital projects.
- 7 The individual capital projects in the category of public
