AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
 - Statutes, providing for the use of certified mail for notice
- 3 of department action.

- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1551 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1551. Notice of department action.
- 9 The department shall promptly notify each person whose
- 10 license or permit is suspended as a result of the accumulation
- 11 of points. The notification that the license or permit is
- 12 suspended shall be made within six months following the
- 13 conviction of a violation of this title that resulted in the
- 14 addition of sufficient points to cause the suspension. The
- 15 notice shall be sent by certified mail, return receipt
- 16 requested, and the cost thereof shall be added to the

- 1 <u>restoration fee.</u> Failure of the department to give prompt notice
- 2 of suspension as required by this section shall prohibit the
- 3 department from suspending the license or permit of such person.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
