## AN ACT

1 2 3	Making appropriations from a restricted revenue account within the General Fund and from Federal augmentation funds to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be
7	necessary, are specifically appropriated from the restricted
8	revenue account within the General Fund and from Federal
9	augmentation funds to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission
10	to provide for the operation of the commission for the fiscal
11	period July 1, 1985, to June 30, 1986, for the purposes and in
12	the amounts shown:
13	Federal State
14	(1) For the salaries, wages
15	and all necessary expenses for the
16	proper operation and administration
17	of the Pennsylvania Public Utility
