## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for the
- 3 precedence of substance over procedure in criminal cases.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 8703. Precedence of substance over procedure.
- 9 In any criminal proceeding, the quilt or innocence of the
- 10 defendant and other matters of substance shall take precedence
- 11 over matters of procedure and no sentence given a convicted
- 12 defendant shall be overturned or reduced because of the
- 13 subsequent discovery of a procedural defect in the proceedings
- 14 which bears no relation to the issue of quilt or innocence.
- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
