AN ACT

Amending the act of June 1, 1945 (P.L.1242, No.428), entitled "An act relating to roads, streets, highways and bridges; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws 3 administered by the Secretary of Highways and by the 5 Department of Highways relating thereto," authorizing municipalities to perform certain work on State highways 6 7 within municipal boundaries; and authorizing certain reimbursements. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. Article V of the act of June 1, 1945 (P.L.1242, No. 428), known as the State Highway Law, is amended by adding a subdivision to read: 13 14 ARTICLE V. 15 RURAL STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM AND STATE HIGHWAYS 16 IN CITIES, BOROUGHS AND TOWNS

- 2 (e) Provisions Applicable to All Municipalities.
- 3 <u>Section 561. Municipal Work and Reimbursement.--(a) Within</u>
- 4 <u>municipal boundaries</u>, every municipality THE MUNICIPALITY AND
- 5 THE DEPARTMENT shall have the power to enter into a contract
- 7 PERFORM MAINTENANCE work on the roadway and shoulders of any
- 8 State highway within the municipal boundaries.
- 9 (b) Each municipality which completes the work described in
- 10 <u>subsection (a) shall be relieved from any tort liability arising</u>
- 11 from AFTER COMPLETION OF such work if the completed project
- 12 conforms to the standards imposed by the department.
- (c) Each municipality shall be entitled to receive
- 14 reimbursement from the department, in accordance with the
- 15 contract, if the work is completed to the standards established
- 16 by the department.
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
