2	thousand five hundred dollars (\$18,500). Each school entity

5	(\$18,500) minimum salary. The adjustment to the schedule or				
6	system shall be made effective upon the expiration of its				
7	current collective bargaining agreement, but in no case later

13	Section 1142.2. State Salary Supplement. For the 1985-1986	<

15	employe or temporary professional employe receiving sixteen				
16	thousand five hundred one dollars (\$16,501) or more on the

18	receive a two thousand dollar (\$2,000) State salary supplement.				
19	The salary supplement shall be in addition to the salaries set				
20	forth in the school entity salary schedule or salary system.				
21	Section 2502.13. State Subsidy on Account of Salary				
22	Supplement. (a) For the 1985-1986 school year and each school				
23	year thereafter, the Commonwealth shall pay to school districts,				
24	intermediate units, State owned schools, community colleges, and				
25	the Department of Education on behalf of its prison schools and				
26	youth development center employes, on account of salaries of all				
27	professional or temporary professional employes below the first				
28	level of supervision, as defined in section 301 of the act of				
29	July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), known as the Public Employe
