AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An  
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain  
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial  
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the  
5 laws relating thereto," further providing for payments on  
6 account of approved vocational extension classes and  
7 preemployment training; and making an editorial change.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. Section 2507 of the act of March 10, 1949  
11 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949,  
12 amended August 14, 1963 (P.L.1121, No.477), is amended to read:

13 Section 2507. Payments on Accounts of Approved Vocational  
14 Extension Classes and Pre-employment Training.--Every school  
15 district and every vocational school district, regardless of  
16 classification, shall be paid by the Commonwealth for every  
17 school year, on account of approved vocational extension classes  
18 and pre-employment training, eighty per cent (80%) of the sum  
19 which was expended by the district for the compensation of  
20 vocational extension and pre-employment training teachers and

1 supervisors. For the purpose of computing reimbursement, the  
2 maximum compensation shall be [four dollars (\$4.00)] twelve  
3 dollars (\$12.00) per hour and the amount expended for  
4 supervisory salaries shall not exceed twenty per cent (20%) of  
5 the sum expended for teachers' salaries: Provided, That in  
6 special cases when travel time or unusual preparation of  
7 instructional materials or other factors result in an inadequate  
8 compensation, the Department of [Public Instruction] Education  
9 may approve additional reimbursable employment time for such  
10 additional services upon the submission of adequate  
11 substantiative evidence from the responsible superintendent of  
12 schools.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
