AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 28, 1937 (P.L.955, No.265), entitled, as amended, "An act to promote public health, safety, morals, 2 3 and welfare by declaring the necessity of creating public bodies, corporate and politic, to be known as housing 4 5 authorities to engage in slum clearance, and to undertake 6 projects, to provide dwelling accommodations for persons of 7 low income; providing for the organization of such housing 8 authorities; defining their powers and duties; providing for 9 the exercise of such powers, including the acquisition of property by purchase, gift or eminent domain, the renting and 10 selling of property, and including borrowing money, issuing 11 bonds, and other obligations, and giving security therefor; 12 13 prescribing the remedies of obligees of housing authorities; 14 authorizing housing authorities to enter into agreements, including agreements with the United States, the 15 Commonwealth, and political subdivisions and municipalities 16 17 thereof; defining the application of zoning, sanitary, and 18 building laws and regulations to projects built or maintained 19 by such housing authorities; exempting the property and 20 securities of such housing authorities from taxation; and 21 imposing duties and conferring powers upon the State Planning 22 Board, and certain other State officers and departments," 23 providing certain additional powers to housing authorities to 24 contract for police services.
- 25 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 26 hereby enacts as follows:
- 27 Section 1. Section 10 of the act of May 28, 1937 (P.L.955,
- 28 No.265), known as the Housing Authorities Law, is amended by

- 1 adding clauses to read:
- 2 Section 10. Powers of an Authority. -- An Authority shall
- 3 constitute a public body, corporate and politic, exercising
- 4 public powers of the Commonwealth as an agency thereof, which
- 5 powers shall include all powers necessary or appropriate to
- 6 carry out and effectuate the purpose and provisions of this act,
- 7 including the following powers, in addition to others herein
- 8 granted:
- 9 * * *
- 10 (qq) In a county of the second class, to appoint police
- 11 officers who shall have the same rights, powers and duties as
- 12 other peace officers in the Commonwealth with respect to the
- 13 property and enforcing order on and adjacent to the grounds and
- 14 buildings of the Authority: Provided, That said police officers
- 15 complete the same course of instruction as is required for
- 16 <u>municipal police officers by the Municipal Police Education and</u>
- 17 Training Law.
- 18 (hh) In a county of the second class, to appoint security
- 19 officers who shall have the same rights, powers and duties as
- 20 police officers in the Commonwealth in and upon the grounds and
- 21 buildings of the Authority and in instances of hot pursuit
- 22 within the boundaries of the county of the second class and who
- 23 shall be authorized to arrest persons for the commission of any
- 24 offense and the keepers of the jails and other places of
- 25 detention in the county of the second class shall receive all
- 26 persons arrested by such security officers for purposes of
- 27 detention until they are dealt with according to law: Provided,
- 28 however, That such security officers successfully complete the
- 29 <u>course of instruction provided under the Municipal Police</u>
- 30 Education and Training Law, where applicable. The Authority

- shall, to the maximum extent practicable, give reference in 1
- 2 <u>hiring security officers first to any person living in public</u>
- 3 housing and receiving any form of State or Federal public
- 4 <u>assistance</u>, and second, to any other person living in public
- housing. 5
- Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 6
