AN ACT

- 1 Making appropriations from the State Employees' Retirement Fund
- 2 to provide for expenses of the State Employees' Retirement
- Board for the fiscal year July 1, 1985, to June 30, 1986, and
- 4 for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the
- 5 close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1985.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. The sum of \$5,020,000, or as much thereof as may
- 9 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the State Employees'
- 10 Retirement Fund to the State Employees' Retirement Board for the
- 11 payment of all salaries, wages and other compensation and travel
- 12 expenses of the employees and members of the State Employees'
- 13 Retirement Board, for contractual services and other expenses
- 14 necessary for the proper conduct of the duties, functions and
- 15 activities of the board for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
- 16 1985, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid
- 17 at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1985.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1985, or
- 19 immediately, whichever is later.
