## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, defining the offense of spray-painting
- 3 vandalism.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 3309. Spray-painting vandalism.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits the offense of spray-
- 10 painting vandalism if he vandalizes, defaces or otherwise
- 11 damages any building, structure, vehicle or other property by
- 12 the use of spray paint.
- 13 (b) Grading.--An offense under subsection (a) is a
- 14 misdemeanor of the third degree punishable by imprisonment for
- 15 90 days in the case of a minor under 18 years of age, and
- 16 punishable by imprisonment for six months in the case of a

- 1 person 18 years of age or older.
- (c) Offense by seller of spray paint. -- Any person who has 2
- 3 sold the spray paint used to commit an offense under this
- 4 <u>section commits a misdemeanor of the third degree punishable by</u>
- 5 <u>a fine of \$1,000 for a first offense and \$5,000 for each</u>
- 6 <u>subsequent offense</u>.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 7
