AN ACT

- 1 Making an appropriation to the Trustees of Drexel University,
- Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The sum of \$4,721,000 \\$4,655,000 is hereby
- 6 appropriated to the Trustees of Drexel University, Philadelphia,
- 7 Pennsylvania, for the fiscal year July 1, 1985, to June 30,
- 8 1986, for instruction and student aid and for participation by a
- 9 representative of the institution, appointed by the chief
- 10 executive officer thereof, as a member of the Pennsylvania
- 11 Academic Commission on Technological Development, a commission
- 12 for interinstitutional communication regarding technological
- 13 innovation and development and for dissemination of information
- 14 on such matters to the Pennsylvania business community and
- 15 others who may use such information for new business and job
- 16 development in Pennsylvania, such commission to be composed of

- 1 representatives of every State-owned or State-related
- 2 educational or scientific institution receiving General Fund
- 3 assistance from the Commonwealth.
- 4 Section 2. Payments to Drexel University on account of the
- 5 appropriation provided in section 1 shall be made by the
- 6 Secretary of Education in equal quarterly payments.
- 7 Section 3. The Drexel University shall provide such
- 8 information and in such form and manner as the Department of
- 9 Education may prescribe.
- 10 Section 4. Drexel University shall report its revenues and
- 11 expenditures and present its financial statements in accordance
- 12 with generally accepted accounting principles and procedures for
- 13 educational institutions as set forth in the "Higher Education
- 14 Finance Manual of 1975," without exception.
- 15 Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1985, or
- 16 immediately, whichever is later.
