## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, imposing a moratorium on the use of a stun gun.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	§ 908.1. Moratorium on use of stun guns.
9	(a) General ruleStun guns are currently not approved by
10	any Federal regulatory agency. In consideration of the possible
11	harm that could be inflicted by the use of this weapon, until
12	guidelines for safe and restricted use can be implemented, a
13	six-month moratorium on the use of a stun gun is imposed.
14	(b) DefinitionAs used in this section the term "stun gun"
15	means a hand held device capable of pumping electric charges
16	into individuals. The purpose of this weapon is to momentarily
17	<u>stun, knock out or paralyze an individual by passing an</u>

1 <u>electrical shock to the individual. One common model is known as</u>

2 <u>the Nova XR-5000</u>.
