## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11	Amending the act of July 17, 1961 (P.L.776, No.341), entitled, as amended, "An act declaring the policy of the Commonwealth with regard to discriminatory practices in educational institutions based upon race, religion, color, ancestry, national origin or sex; prohibiting such discriminatory practices; providing for procedure and enforcement; providing for judicial review; providing for administration by the Pennsylvania Human Relations Commission in the Department of Labor and Industry; and defining its functions, powers and duties hereunder, "further providing for unfair educational practices.

13	hereby enacts as follows:	
14	Section 1. The act of July 17, 1961 (P.L.776, No.341), known	
15	as the Pennsylvania Fair Educational Opportunities Act, is	
16	amended by adding a section to read:	
17	Section 4.1. Unfair Educational Practices Involving	
18	Religious Beliefs OBSERVANCE OF RELIGIOUS HOLIDAYS (a) It	<
19	shall be an unfair educational practice for an educational	
20	<u>institution:</u>	
21	(1) To expel, suspend, punish, deny facilities to or	

1 otherwise discriminate against any student who is unable, because of his religious beliefs OBSERVANCE OF A RELIGIOUS 2 <---3 HOLIDAY, to attend classes or to participate in any examination, 4 study or work requirements on a particular day or days. 5 (2) To deny any student who is absent because of his religious beliefs OBSERVANCE OF A RELIGIOUS HOLIDAY any award or 6 7 the opportunity to compete for any award. 8 (3) To deprive any student who is unable, because of his 9 religious beliefs OBSERVANCE OF A RELIGIOUS HOLIDAY, to attend 10 classes on a particular day or days the opportunity to take an 11 alternative test or examination or to make up any study or work requirements which he missed because of such absence. 12 13 (b) It shall be the duty of the faculty and of the administrative officials of each educational institution to make 14 15 available to each student who is absent from the educational 16 institution because of his religious beliefs OBSERVANCE OF A 17 RELIGIOUS HOLIDAY an equivalent opportunity to compete for any 18 award and to make up any examination, study or work requirements 19 or class which he may have missed because of such absence on any 20 particular day or days. No fees of any kind shall be charged by the educational institution for making available to the student 21 22 such equivalent opportunity. 23 (c) Any absence because of a student's religious beliefs 24 OBSERVANCE OF A RELIGIOUS HOLIDAY shall be recorded as an 25 excused absence on the student's attendance record or on the 26 record of any group or class of which he is a member. Any 27 transcript, application, employment form or any similar form on 28 which information concerning a student's attendance record is 29 requested shall show, with respect to absences, only absences 30 other than absences excused because of religious beliefs

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- 1 OBSERVANCE OF RELIGIOUS HOLIDAYS.
- 2 (d) In effectuating the provisions of this section, it shall

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- 3 be the duty of the faculty and of the administrative officials
- 4 <u>of each educational institution to exercise the fullest measure</u>
- 5 of good faith. No adverse or prejudicial effects shall result to
- 6 any student for the reason that he has availed himself of the
- 7 provisions of this section.
- 8 (e) A copy of this section shall be published by each
- 9 educational institution in the catalog which contains the
- 10 <u>educational institution's rules and regulations or lists the</u>
- 11 <u>educational institution's available courses.</u>
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
