AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of December 22, 1983 (P.L.306, No.84), entitled
- 2 "An act providing for the State Board of Vehicle
- 3 Manufacturers, Dealers and Salespersons; and providing
- 4 penalties, "further providing for grounds for disciplinary
- 5 proceedings.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 10 of the act of December 22, 1983
- 9 (P.L.306, No.84), known as the Board of Vehicles Act, is amended
- 10 by adding a clause to read:
- 11 Section 10. Grounds for disciplinary proceedings.
- 12 The board shall have the power to formally reprimand, suspend
- 13 or revoke any license or refuse to issue or renew any license of
- 14 an applicant or licensee or a person required to be licensed
- 15 under this act, if after due notice of and hearing, the person
- 16 charged is found in violation of or fails to carry out the acts
- 17 and procedures set forth in sections 5 and 8 or is found guilty
- 18 of committing or attempting to commit any of the acts set forth
- 19 in section 13 or any of the following acts:

2	(27) Being a dealer, broker or salesperson who fails to
3	provide to a purchaser of a mobile home, prior to entering
4	into any contract or agreement for the sale or transfer of
5	ownership of the mobile home, a statement as to:
6	(i) whether or not there is any mortgage, judgment
7	or other lien of record, including a tax lien, against
8	the mobile home; and
9	(ii) whether or not any taxes levied against the
10	mobile home which are currently due and owing have been
11	paid.
12	Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 1987.
