- 2 (H) SUNSET.--THE PENNSYLVANIA TRAUMA SYSTEMS FOUNDATION
- 3 SHALL TERMINATE DECEMBER 31, 1996, UNLESS EXTENDED BY THE
- 4 GENERAL ASSEMBLY UNDER THE ACT OF DECEMBER 22, 1981 (P.L.508,
- 5 NO.142), KNOWN AS THE SUNSET ACT.
- 6 Section 1 2. Section 14 of the act of July 3, 1985 (P.L.164, <---
- 7 No.45), known as the Emergency Medical Services Act, is amended

- 9 Section 14. [Support of emergency medical services] Emergency

- 11 [(a) Fine.--A \$10 fine shall be levied on all moving traffic
