AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 16, 1866 (P.L.105, No.93), entitled
2 "An act to authorize the inspectors and warden of any of the
3 penitentiaries to permit the use of tobacco, by convicts, as
4 a reward for good conduct," providing that inmates shall not
5 receive tobacco at Commonwealth expense; and making editorial
6 changes.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. The title and section 1 of the act of April 16,
10 1866 (P.L.105, No.93), entitled "An act to authorize the
11 inspectors and warden of any of the penitentiaries to permit the
12 use of tobacco, by convicts, as a reward for good conduct," are
13 amended to read:

14 AN ACT

15 To authorize the [inspectors] board of trustees and warden of
16 any of the penitentiaries to permit the use of tobacco, by
17 [convicts] inmates, as a reward for good conduct.

18 Section 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of
19 Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General

1 Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the
2 same, That the [inspectors] board of trustees and warden of
3 either of the penitentiaries of the state, may permit any
4 [convict] inmate, in said penitentiary, to use tobacco, to a
5 limited extent, as a reward for good conduct, on the part of any
6 such [convict] inmate, under such restrictions as may be
7 prescribed. No inmate shall receive tobacco at Commonwealth
8 expense.

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
