## AN ACT

- Amending the act of December 22, 1981 (P.L.508, No.142), 2 entitled "An act requiring the termination of certain agencies of State Government under certain circumstances, 3 4 creating a Leadership Committee with certain powers and duties and imposing powers and duties upon the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee, "further providing for the powers of the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee; and making an editorial change.
- 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 10 hereby enacts as follows:
- 11 Section 1. Sections 11 and 12 of the act of December 22,
- 1981 (P.L.508, No.142), known as the Sunset Act, are amended to 12
- 13 read:
- 14 Section 11. Access to records and witnesses.
- 15 The Legislative Budget and Finance Committee and its
- 16 authorized representative shall, for the purpose of examination
- and audit authorized by this act, have ready access to persons 17
- 18 and may examine and copy to the extent deemed necessary to its
- 19 evaluation and review, pertinent records, accounts, papers,

- 1 reports, vouchers, correspondence, personnel information, books
- 2 and other documentation of any Commonwealth agency. The
- 3 Legislative Budget and Finance Committee shall determine the
- 4 <u>extent of access, examination and copying necessary for</u>
- 5 <u>evaluation and review and shall determine the pertinence of</u>
- 6 records, accounts, papers, reports, vouchers, correspondence,
- 7 personnel information, books and other documentation of any
- 8 <u>Commonwealth agency</u>.
- 9 Section 12. Authority to administer oaths, subpoena witnesses
- and records and take depositions.
- 11 For the purpose of this act, the Legislative Budget and
- 12 Finance Committee[, with the concurrent resolution of both
- 13 Houses] shall have the power to issue subpoenas, under the hand
- 14 and seal of the chairman; to compel the attendance of witnesses
- 15 and the production of any papers, books, accounts and documents
- 16 [to subpoena witnesses,]; to take testimony under oath; to cause
- 17 the deposition of witnesses, residing within or without the
- 18 Commonwealth, to be taken in the manner prescribed by law; and
- 19 to assemble records and documents, by subpoena or otherwise,
- 20 with the same power and authority as courts of record [and]. The
- 21 <u>committee</u> may apply to courts of record for the enforcement of
- 22 these powers.
- 23 Any person who willfully neglects or refuses to comply with
- 24 any subpoena issued in behalf of the Legislative Budget and
- 25 Finance Committee, or refuses to testify to any matters
- 26 regarding which he may be lawfully interrogated, shall be
- 27 subject to [the penalties provided by the laws of the
- 28 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania] 18 Pa.C.S. § 5110 (relating to
- 29 <u>contempt of General Assembly</u>).
- 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
