AN ACT

Amending the act of May 23, 1945 (P.L.903, No.362), entitled "An

2 act authorizing cities of the third class to establish an 3 optional retirement system for officers and employes independently of any pension system or systems existing in 5 such cities," further providing for membership on certain 6 retirement boards. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 3 of the act of May 23, 1945 (P.L.903, 10 No.362), entitled "An act authorizing cities of the third class 11 to establish an optional retirement system for officers and 12 employes independently of any pension system or systems existing in such cities, " is amended to read: 13 14 Section 3. In any such city which creates such retirement system there shall be created a board to be known as the 15 16 "Officers and Employes Retirement Board," consisting of the mayor, the city controller, the director of finance, [and] two 17 employes to be chosen by the employes contributing to the 18 retirement fund and if members of council participate in the 19

- 1 retirement fund and are members of the fund, a member of
- 2 <u>council</u>, <u>chosen by council</u>. It shall be the duty of said board
- 3 to register all persons employed by the said city, and to
- 4 administer the collections and distribution of the fund, herein
- 5 provided for, and make such reasonable rules in the premises as
- 6 such board may deem necessary to carry into effect the
- 7 provisions of this act.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
