AN ACT

- Relating to the observation of manufacture or construction by
- certain licensees; and providing for approval by licensees of
- 3 changes in documents and for responsibility in connection
- 4 therewith.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Definitions.
- 8 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 9 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 10 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 11 "Document." Drawings, specifications, plans, plates and
- 12 reports prepared in connection with the design and construction
- 13 of a structure or group of structures, including public and
- 14 private buildings, and the utilization of space within and
- 15 surrounding such structures, and those prepared in connection
- 16 with the design and manufacture of machines, equipment or for
- 17 utilization in processes or systems.
- 18 "Licensee." An architect licensed under the act of December

- 1 14, 1982 (P.L.1227, No.281), known as the Architects Licensure
- 2 Law, a professional engineer or professional land surveyor
- 3 licensed under act of May 23, 1945 (P.L.913, No.367), known as
- 4 the Professional Engineers Registration Law, or a landscape
- 5 architect licensed under the act of January 24, 1966 (1965
- 6 P.L.1527, No.535), known as the Landscape Architects'
- 7 Registration Law.
- 8 "Seal." The seal, stamp or facsimile thereof which a
- 9 licensee is required by law to affix or impress on all documents
- 10 prepared by the licensee or under the licensee's supervision.
- 11 Section 2. Observation of manufacture or construction.
- 12 Affixing or impressing a seal on documents shall not impose a
- 13 legal duty or responsibility upon the licensee so affixing the
- 14 seal to observe the construction or manufacture which is the
- 15 subject of the documents. This section shall not, however,
- 16 preclude a licensee from entering into a contractual agreement
- 17 which includes the provision of manufacture or construction
- 18 observation services.
- 19 Section 3. Subsequent changes.
- 20 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a licensee who
- 21 affixes or impresses a seal to documents shall not be
- 22 responsible for damage caused by subsequent changes to or use of
- 23 those documents where the subsequent changes or uses, including
- 24 changes or uses made by the Commonwealth or any political
- 25 subdivision or agency or authority thereof, are not authorized
- 26 or approved by the licensee who originally affixed or impressed
- 27 a seal on the documents.
- 28 Section 4. Applicability.
- 29 This act shall apply to any claims made after the effective
- 30 date with respect to documents to which a seal has been or will

- 1 be affixed or impressed whether before or after the effective
- 2 date.
- 3 Section 5. Effective date.
- 4 This act shall take effect immediately.
