## AN ACT

Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for the filling of vacancies in certain county offices.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 501 of the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), known as The County Code, is amended to read:

Section 501. Election; Vacancies.--(a) Three county commissioners shall be elected in each county in the year one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five, and every fourth year thereafter. In the election of commissioners, each qualified elector shall vote for no more than two persons. The three persons having the highest number of votes shall be elected.
(b) Any casual vacancy in the office of county commissioners shall be filled, for the balance of the unexpired term, by the [court of common pleas of the] county chairman, with the
approval of the county committee, of the same political party as
the individual who vacated the office in which such vacancy
shall occur by the appointment of a registered elector of the
county who was a member of the same political party as the
commissioner whose place is to be filled at the time the
commissioner was elected.
Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
