AN ACT

- 1 Conferring police powers on Federal law enforcement officers in certain circumstances.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Arrest authorized.
- 6 The following persons employed as full-time law enforcement
- 7 officers by the Federal Government, who are empowered to effect
- 8 an arrest with or without warrant for violations of the United
- 9 States Code and who are authorized to carry firearms in the
- 10 performance of their duties, shall be empowered to act as an
- 11 officer for the arrest of offenders against the laws of this
- 12 Commonwealth where the person reasonably believes that a felony
- 13 of the first, second or third degree is about to be committed or
- 14 attempted in his presence:
- 15 (1) Federal Bureau of Investigation special agents.
- 16 (2) United States Secret Service special agents.
- 17 (3) Immigration and Naturalization Service special

- 1 agents, investigators and patrol officers.
- 2 (4) United States Marshals Service deputies.
- 3 (5) Drug Enforcement Administration special agents.
- 4 (6) Federal Protective Officers.
- 5 (7) United States Customs Service special agents,
- 6 inspectors and patrol officers.
- 7 (8) United States park police.
- 8 (9) Federal parole officers.
- 9 (10) United States General Services Administration
- 10 special agents.
- 11 (11) United States Department of Agriculture special
- 12 agents.
- 13 (12) Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms special
- 14 agents.
- 15 (13) Internal Revenue Service special agents and
- 16 inspectors.
- 17 (14) Naval Investigative Service special agents.
- 18 (15) United States Fish and Wildlife Service special
- 19 agents.
- 20 (16) United States Department of State special agents.
- 21 (17) Department of Defense police officers, detectives
- 22 and criminal investigators.
- 23 (18) United States Postal Service inspectors.
- 24 Section 2. Effective date.
- 25 This act shall take effect immediately.
