AN ACT

Amending the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), entitled "An act relating to the manufacture, sale and possession of controlled substances, other drugs, devices and cosmetics; 4 conferring powers on the courts and the secretary and Department of Health, and a newly created Pennsylvania Drug, 6 Device and Cosmetic Board; establishing schedules of 7 controlled substances; providing penalties; requiring 8 registration of persons engaged in the drug trade and for the 9 revocation or suspension of certain licenses and registrations; and repealing an act, providing that a 10 conviction for the sale of certain controlled substances 11

would result in an automatic mandatory ten-year sentence.

- 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 14 hereby enacts as follows:

15 Section 1. Section 13 of the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233,

- 1 No.64), known as The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and
- 2 Cosmetic Act, is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 3 Section 13. Prohibited Acts; Penalties.--* * *
- 4 (1) Notwithstanding any other provision in this act, any
- 5 person, not a registrant, who sells, delivers, offers for sale,
- 6 holds for sale, or gives away any heroin or any coca leaves and
- 7 any salt, compound, derivative, or preparation of coca leaves,
- 8 or any preparation thereof which is chemically equivalent or
- 9 <u>identical with any of these substances</u>, but not including
- 10 <u>decocainized coca leaves or extracts of coca leaves, which</u>
- 11 extracts do not contain cocaine or ecgonine, shall be guilty of
- 12 <u>a felony</u>, and shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to
- 13 <u>imprisonment for not less than ten years.</u>
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
