A RESOLUTION

1 Memorializing Congress to study the possibility of erecting a
2 memorial for the soldiers who served during the Korean
3 Conflict.

4 WHEREAS, The men and women of the armed forces of the United
5 States who served their country from June 25, 1950, to July 27,
6 1953, during the Korean Conflict should be properly honored; and

7 WHEREAS, These soldiers who served with dedication and
8 devotion deserve recognition, respect and honor; and

9 WHEREAS, The erection of a memorial, by the Federal
10 Government, to commemorate the soldiers who risked their lives
11 and so bravely and patriotically served their country would be
12 an appropriate tribute to these soldiers who fought during the
13 Korean Conflict; therefore be it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
15 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania urge the Congress of the United
16 States to study the possibility of erecting a memorial for the

1 soldiers who served during the Korean Conflict; and be it
2 further

3 RESOLVED, That copies of this resoltuion be transmitted to
4 the presiding officers of each house of Congress and to each
5 member of Congress from Pennsylvania.
