AN ACT

Amending Titles 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) and 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, funding local police programs; and increasing summary traffic fines.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section $3573(b)$ of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
§ 3573. Municipal corporation portion of fines, etc.

(b) Vehicle offenses.--

(4) When prosecution for a summary traffic offense under

Title 75 is the result of local police action, $\$ 1$ of each
fine collected shall be payable to the municipal corporation
under which the local police are organized, to be used solely
for equipment purchases and training programs.

Section 2. Section $6502(a)$ of Title 75 is amended to read:
§ 6502. Summary offenses.
(a) Violations of this title.--It is a summary offense for any person to violate any of the provisions of this title unless the violation is by this title or other statute of this Commonwealth declared to be a misdemeanor or felony. Every person convicted of a summary offense for a violation of any of the provisions of this title for which another penalty is not provided shall be sentenced to pay a fine of [\$25] \$26.

Section 3. This act shall take effect in 30 days.
