10	(b) Police, fire and coroner or medical examiner vehicles
11	(1) Police, coroner[,] <u>or</u> medical examiner [or fire
12	police] vehicles may in addition to the requirements of
13	subsection (a) be equipped with revolving or flashing blue
14	lights. The combination of red and blue lights may be used
15	only on police, coroner[,] <u>or</u> medical examiner [or fire
16	police] vehicles.
17	(2) Unmarked police webigles used as emergency webigles

17 (2) Unmarked police vehicles, used as emergency vehicles
 18 and equipped with audible warning systems, may be equipped

1 with the lights described in this section.

(3) Police and fire vehicles may be equipped with a
mounted rack containing one or more emergency warning lights
or side mounted floodlights or alley lights or all such
lights.
