AN ACT

1 2 3 4	Amending the act of July 20, 1917 (P.L.1158, No.401), entitled "An act to fix, regulate, and establish the fees to be charged and received by constables in this Commonwealth," further providing for mileage of constables.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
б	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 1 of the act of July 20, 1917 (P.L.1158,
8	No.401), referred to as the Constable Fee Law, amended May 9,
9	1974 (P.L.275, No.78) and October 10, 1974 (P.L.710, No.237), is
10	amended to read:
11	Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That, from and after the
12	passage of this act, the fees to be charged and received by
13	constables in this Commonwealth shall be as follows:
14	For executing a warrant on behalf of the Commonwealth or a
15	political subdivision thereof, for each defendant, five dollars
16	plus [fifteen cents for each mile] <u>mileage</u> as hereinafter <
17	provided.

For conveying defendants, except vagrants, to jail, on mittimus or warrants, for each defendant, five dollars plus fifteen cents per mile.<u>] mileage as hereinafter provided.</u> Where <---more than one defendant is conveyed simultaneously, the constable shall be reimbursed only for the miles actually traveled. In no case shall the constable be reimbursed for the mileage as if each defendant were conveyed separately.

8 For arresting persons guilty of a breach of the peace, 9 riotous or disorderly conduct, drunkenness, or who may be 10 engaged in the commission of any unlawful act tending to imperil 11 the personal security or endanger the property of the citizens, or violating any ordinance of any borough, township or political 12 13 subdivision, for the violation of which a fine or penalty is 14 imposed, or offending or suspected of offending against the laws 15 of this Commonwealth, protecting timberlands, or the violation 16 of any other law of this Commonwealth authorizing arrest by 17 constable without process, and bringing such offender before a 18 justice of the peace, for each defendant, five dollars; and for 19 every act in or about the arrest or commitment of vagrants, five 20 dollars for each vagrant so arrested, or arrested and committed, 21 and mileage as hereinafter provided.

For levying a fine or forfeiture on a warrant, fifty cents. For taking the body of a defendant into custody on a warrant, where bail is afterwards entered before delivery of body to the jailer, five dollars.

26 For executing discharge to jailer, five dollars.

27 For executing bail-piece, two dollars fifty cents.

For executing a search-warrant, and making return thereon, one dollar.

30 For making returns to the court of common pleas, two dollars 19870H0362B1921 - 2 - 1 and fifty cents.

For serving summons, complaints, notices on suitor or tenant,
either personally or by leaving copy, five dollars plus one
dollar fifty cents for each additional defendant.

5 For serving subpoena, in all cases, five dollars for the 6 first witness, plus fifteen cents for each mile, plus two 7 dollars for each additional witness.

8 For executing landlord's warrant, three dollars.

9 For taking inventory of goods, each item, two cents.

10 For levying or distraining goods, including schedule of 11 property levied upon and set aside, fifteen dollars.

12 For advertising personal property to public sale, two dollars 13 and fifty cents.

14 For appraisement on landlord's distraint, five dollars.

15 For posting notice of execution sale or sale on landlord's 16 distraint and advertisement, plus actual cost of advertising, 17 five dollars.

18 For selling goods levied or distrained, ten dollars.

19 For clerk hire at said sales, when necessary, ten dollars per 20 day.

For watchman taking charge of property levied on, when necessary, ten dollars per day, also reasonable expenses of insurance, arranging goods for sale, heat, light, storage, rent, transportation, feeding livestock, and similar expenses incurred in caring for and keeping goods and chattels levied upon, when the same is necessary and advantageous, or when requested by the plaintiff or defendant to incur such expense.

For receiving and paying over money paid after a levy,
without sale, one dollar and fifty cents.

30 For bill of sale, when demanded, each item two cents. 19870H0362B1921 - 3 - For putting up notice of distress on the premises, fifty
 cents.

3 For making return of no levy or not found on any process, one4 dollar fifty cents.

5 For executing order for possession, seven dollars.

For forcible ejectment on order for possession, twenty-fivedollars.

8 For serving complaint in landlord and tenant proceedings,9 five dollars.

10 For taking inventory of goods on an execution, each item, two 11 cents.

12 For appraising property where exemption is claimed by 13 defendant, one dollar.

14 For traveling expenses in the performance of any duty or 15 service hereinbefore set forth, or in the performance of any 16 other duty or service required by law, each mile going and 17 returning, fifteen cents to be computed by the route usually <-----18 traveled in going from points and places where said constables may reside, or where he receives any paper to be executed, to 19 20 the points or places required to be traveled: Provided, That in $\frac{1}{2}$ <----21 a rate per mile which is equal to the maximum standard mileage 22 rate allowed as a business deduction by the Internal Revenue Service, regardless of the number of miles traveled. Actual 23 24 mileage traveled shall be computed using the issuing authority's 25 office or the constable's place of business, whichever is less. 26 Constables shall be compensated for other travel expenses not to 27 exceed accountable expenses if travel is by other than motor vehicle. In no case shall more mileage be demanded or received 28 29 than for the miles actually traveled except that in all 30 political subdivisions other than cities of the first class a 19870H0362B1921 - 4 -

1 minimum fee of one dollar fifty cents shall be allowed as

2 mileage.

For services not herein specially provided for the same feemay be charged and received as for similar services.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
