## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 71 (State Government) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, to include certain Federal service as
- 3 nonstate service.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 5304(c) of Title 71 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 5304. Creditable nonstate service.
- 9 \* \* \*
- 10 (c) Limitations on nonstate service.--Creditable nonstate
- 11 service credit shall be limited to:
- 12 (1) intervening military service;
- 13 (2) other military service not exceeding five years;
- 14 (3) service in any public school or public educational
- institution in any state other than this Commonwealth or in
- any territory or area under the jurisdiction of the United
- 17 States; or service as an administrator, teacher, or

- 1 instructor in the field of education for any agency or
- department of the government of the United States, whether or
- 3 not such area was under the jurisdiction of the United
- 4 States, the total of such service not exceeding the lesser of
- 5 ten years or the number of years of active membership in the
- 6 system, as an officer or employee of the Department of
- 7 Education or as an administrator, teacher, or instructor
- 8 employed in any State-owned educational institution or The
- 9 Pennsylvania State University; [or]
- 10 (4) previous service with a governmental agency other
- than the Commonwealth which employment with said agency was
- terminated because of the transfer by statute of the
- administration of such service or of the entire agency to the
- 14 Commonwealth[.]; or
- 15 (5) service as a temporary Federal employee assigned to
- an air quality control complement for the Pennsylvania
- 17 <u>Department of Environmental Resources at any time during the</u>
- 18 period of 1970 through 1975. This service time may be
- 19 purchased only if the member makes an election to purchase
- 20 within one year of the effective date of this paragraph and
- 21 <u>the member shall pay an amount which is equal to the full</u>
- 22 actuarial cost of the increased benefit obtained by virtue of

- 25 SECTION 2. SECTION 5505 OF TITLE 71 IS AMENDED BY ADDING A
- 26 SUBSECTION TO READ:
- 27 § 5505. CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THE PURCHASE OF CREDIT FOR CREDITABLE
- NONSTATE SERVICE.

- 30 (F) TEMPORARY FEDERAL SERVICE.--CONTRIBUTIONS ON ACCOUNT OF

- 1 CREDIT FOR SERVICE AS A TEMPORARY FEDERAL EMPLOYEE ASSIGNED TO
- 2 AN AIR QUALITY CONTROL COMPLEMENT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 3 ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES DURING THE PERIOD OF 1970 THROUGH 1975,
- 4 AS AUTHORIZED IN SECTION 5304(C)(5) (RELATING TO CREDITABLE
- 5 NONSTATE SERVICE), SHALL BE EQUAL TO THE FULL ACTUARIAL COST OF
- 6 THE INCREASED BENEFIT OBTAINED BY VIRTUE OF THE PURCHASE. THE
- 7 INCREASED BENEFIT ATTRIBUTABLE TO THE PURCHASED SERVICE SHALL BE
- 8 THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN:
- 9 (1) THE ANNUAL AMOUNT OF A STANDARD SINGLE LIFE ANNUITY,
- 10 BEGINNING AT THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE SUPERANNUATION AGE,
- 11 <u>CALCULATED ASSUMING NO FUTURE SALARY INCREASES, ASSUMING</u>
- 12 CREDIT FOR THE SERVICE TO BE PURCHASED; AND
- 13 (2) THE ANNUAL AMOUNT OF A STANDARD SINGLE LIFE ANNUITY,
- 14 CALCULATED ON THE SAME BASIS, BUT EXCLUDING CREDIT FOR THE
- 15 <u>SERVICE TO BE PURCHASED.</u>
- 16 THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE SUPERANNUATION AGE SHALL BE THE AGE AT
- 17 WHICH THE MEMBER BECOMES FIRST ELIGIBLE FOR SUPERANNUATION
- 18 RETIREMENT ASSUMING CONTINUED FULL-TIME SERVICE AND CREDIT FOR
- 19 THE AMOUNT OF SERVICE WHICH THE MEMBER HAS ELECTED TO PURCHASE,
- 20 OR THE CURRENT ATTAINED AGE OF THE MEMBER, WHICHEVER IS LATER.
- 21 THE FULL ACTUARIAL COST OF THE INCREASED BENEFIT ATTRIBUTABLE TO
- 22 THE PURCHASED SERVICE SHALL BE THE ACTUARIAL PRESENT VALUE OF A
- 23 DEFERRED ANNUITY EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT OF THE INCREASED BENEFIT
- 24 <u>DETERMINED ABOVE</u>, <u>BEGINNING AT THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE</u>
- 25 SUPERANNUATION AGE AND PAYABLE FOR LIFE, CALCULATED USING A
- 26 PRERETIREMENT INTEREST ASSUMPTION OF 1 1/2%, A POSTRETIREMENT
- 27 INTEREST ASSUMPTION OF 4%, NO PRERETIREMENT MORTALITY ASSUMPTION
- 28 AND STANDARD POSTRETIREMENT MORTALITY ASSUMPTIONS. THE PURCHASE
- 29 PAYMENT SHALL BE MADE IN LUMP SUM BY THE MEMBER WITHIN 30 DAYS
- 30 OF CERTIFICATION BY THE BOARD OF THE REOUIRED PURCHASE AMOUNT OR

- 1 MAY BE AMORTIZED THROUGH SALARY DEDUCTIONS IN AMOUNTS AGREED
- 2 UPON BY THE MEMBER AND THE BOARD WITH INTEREST PAYABLE ON THE
- 3 <u>UNPAID BALANCE AT THE RATE APPLICABLE TO THE MOST RECENTLY</u>
- 4 <u>ISSUED 30-YEAR BONDS OF THE UNITED STATES TREASURY DEPARTMENT.</u>
- 5 Section  $\frac{2}{3}$ . This act shall take effect immediately.
