## AN ACT

- Amending the act of November 30, 1965 (P.L.847, No.356), entitled "An act relating to and regulating the business of banking and the exercise by corporations of fiduciary powers; 3 affecting persons engaged in the business of banking and 5 corporations exercising fiduciary powers and affiliates of 6 such persons; affecting the shareholders of such persons and 7 the directors, trustees, officers, attorneys and employes of 8 such persons and of the affiliates of such persons; affecting 9 national banks located in the Commonwealth; affecting persons dealing with persons engaged in the business of banking, 10 corporations exercising fiduciary powers and national banks; 11 conferring powers and imposing duties on the Banking Board, 12 13 on certain departments and officers of the Commonwealth and 14 on courts, prothonotaries, clerks and recorders of deeds; providing penalties; and repealing certain acts and parts of 15 acts," providing for a fixed holiday on May 19. 16

- 18 hereby enacts as follows:
- 19 Section 1. Section 113(a) of the act of November 30, 1965
- 20 (P.L.847, No.356), known as the Banking Code of 1965, amended
- 21 December 13, 1985 (P.L.331, No.89), is amended to read:
- 22 Section 113. Legal Holidays
- 23 (a) Fixed holidays--An institution shall observe as a legal
- 24 holiday:

1 (i) New Year's Day (January 1); 2 (i.1) Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (the third Monday 3 in January); (i.2) Malcolm X Day (May 19); 4 5 (ii) Memorial Day (the last Monday in May); (iii) Independence Day (July 4); 6 7 (iv) Labor Day (the first Monday in September); 8 Thanksgiving Day (the fourth Thursday in November); (vi) Christmas Day (December 25); 9 (vii) each Sunday; 10 (viii) each Monday following an Independence Day, a 11 12 Christmas Day or New Year's Day which occurs on a Sunday; and 13 (ix) each day specifically appointed by the President of 14 the United States or the Governor of the Commonwealth as a legal holiday or as a bank holiday. 15 \* \* \* 16

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
