7	Section 1. The bridge presently under construction over the	
8	Susquehanna River on State Route 642 connecting the Borough of	
9	Milton in Northumberland County and the Borough VILLAGE of West	<
10	Milton in Union County is hereby officially designated and shall	
11	be known as the Governor James Pollock MEMORIAL Bridge.	<
12	Section 2. The Secretary of Transportation shall erect	
13	suitable markers to implement this act.
