L7	(1) (i) is administering an examination of the holder	
L8	of the learner's permit as authorized in section 1508

- 22 (B.1) USE OF SIDE STOP SIGNAL ARMS.--EVERY SCHOOL BUS SHALL
- 23 BE EQUIPPED WITH A SIDE STOP SIGNAL ARM ON THE LEFT SIDE OF THE
- 24 VEHICLE. THE SIDE STOP SIGNAL ARMS SHALL BE AUTOMATICALLY
- 25 ACTIVATED WHENEVER THE BUS IS STOPPED WITH THE RED VISUAL
- 26 <u>SIGNALS IN THE USE AND SHALL ITSELF CONTAIN A FLASHING RED LIGHT</u>

- 12 FOR SCHOOL BUSES), MAY, WHEN IN AN EXTENDED POSITION DISPLAYING
