5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	<u>§ 7508. Furnishing drug-free urine.</u>
10	<u>A person commits a misdemeanor of the third degree if he</u>
11	offers for sale, sells, causes to be sold, gives, furnishes or
12	conveys any amount of drug-free urine for the purpose of, or
13	which is used for, evading or deceiving a test for the presence
14	<u>of drugs.</u>
15	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
