## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to the finances of the State 2 3 government; providing for the settlement, assessment, 4 collection, and lien of taxes, bonus, and all other accounts due the Commonwealth, the collection and recovery of fees and other money or property due or belonging to the Commonwealth, 6 7 or any agency thereof, including escheated property and the 8 proceeds of its sale, the custody and disbursement or other 9 disposition of funds and securities belonging to or in the possession of the Commonwealth, and the settlement of claims 10 against the Commonwealth, the resettlement of accounts and 11 12 appeals to the courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to 13 the Commonwealth, auditing the accounts of the Commonwealth and all agencies thereof, of all public officers collecting 14 15 moneys payable to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth, 16 17 authorizing the Commonwealth to issue tax anticipation notes 18 to defray current expenses, implementing the provisions of 19 section 7(a) of Article VIII of the Constitution of 20 Pennsylvania authorizing and restricting the incurring of 21 certain debt and imposing penalties; affecting every department, board, commission, and officer of the State 22 23 government, every political subdivision of the State, and 24 certain officers of such subdivisions, every person, association, and corporation required to pay, assess, or 25 26 collect taxes, or to make returns or reports under the laws 27 imposing taxes for State purposes, or to pay license fees or other moneys to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 28 29 every State depository and every debtor or creditor of the 30 Commonwealth, " further providing for State depositories.

- 2 Section 1. Section 505 of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343,
- 3 No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, is amended by adding a

- 5 Section 505. State Depositories. -- The Board of Finance and
- 6 Revenue shall have the power, and its duty shall be,
- 7 \* \* \*
- 8 (b.1) To select, as depositories for State funds, savings
- 9 <u>associations</u>, <u>savings</u> <u>banks</u>, <u>Federal savings</u> <u>and loan</u>
- 10 <u>associations and Federal savings banks whose principal offices</u>
- 11 are in this Commonwealth. Statutory provisions requiring money
- 12 to be deposited in an account that is subject to withdrawal by
- 13 check or otherwise on demand shall be satisfied by depositing
- 14 the money in an account that is subject to withdrawal by a
- 15 <u>negotiable order of withdrawal.</u>

- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
