AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 24 (Education) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, providing for eligibility, notification and payment
- 3 for medical insurance.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 24 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 8313. Eligibility for medical insurance contributions.
- 9 An annuitant who has attained superannuation or has 25 years
- 10 of credited service, or a disability annuitant, shall be
- 11 eligible to receive contributions by the Commonwealth to fully
- 12 pay medical, major medical and hospitalization insurance
- 13 coverage if the annuitant has elected coverage in accordance
- 14 with section 8505(i) (relating to duties of board regarding
- 15 applications and elections of members).

- 1 AN ANNUITANT SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE CONTRIBUTIONS BY
- 2 THE COMMONWEALTH TOWARD PAYMENT OF AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE COST
- 3 OF A MEDICARE SUPPLEMENT, MAJOR MEDICAL AND HOSPITALIZATION
- 4 INSURANCE COVERAGE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 8505(I) (RELATING
- 5 TO DUTIES OF BOARD REGARDING APPLICATIONS AND ELECTIONS OF
- 6 MEMBERS) IF THE ANNUITANT IS:
- 7 (1) A SUPERANNUATION ANNUITANT;
- 8 (2) AN ANNUITANT WITH 25 OR MORE YEARS OF CREDITED
- 9 SERVICE; OR
- 10 (3) A DISABILITY ANNUITANT.
- 11 Section 2. Section 8326 of Title 24 is amended by adding a
- 12 subsection to read:
- 13 § 8326. Contributions by the Commonwealth.

- 15 (c) Contributions for medical insurance coverage. -- The
- 16 Commonwealth shall make contributions to the fund on behalf of
- 17 all annuitants eligible to receive medical insurance
- 18 contributions in accordance with section 8313 (relating to
- 19 eligibility for medical insurance contributions) in an amount
- 20 <u>certified by the board as necessary to fund the additional</u>
- 21 liabilities for payments on behalf of annuitants in accordance
- 22 with section 8505(i) (relating to duties of board regarding
- 23 applications and elections of members). IN THE CASE OF AN
- 24 <u>INSURANCE CARRIER OTHER THAN CAPITAL BLUE CROSS/BLUE SHIELD 65</u>
- 25 SPECIAL, THE COMMONWEALTH CONTRIBUTION SHALL BE AT A PEGGED RATE

- 27 Section 3. Section 8505(i) of Title 24 is amended to read:
- 28 § 8505. Duties of board regarding applications and elections of
- members.

- 1 (i) Medical insurance coverage. -- Upon receipt of
- 2 notification from an insurance carrier approved by the board
- 3 that an annuitant who has [attained [age 65] superannuation has <---
- 4 elected medical, major medicalf, and hospitalization insurance <---
- 5 coverage, the board shall deduct, in equal monthly installments <---
- 6 from the annuity payments, the appropriate annual charges {in <—
- 7 equal monthly installments | less any Commonwealth contributions <---
- 8 <u>for medical insurance coverage on behalf of the annuitant</u>. Such
- 9 deductions shall be transmitted to the insurance carrier.] On <---
- 10 behalf of each annuitant eligible in accordance with section
- 11 <u>8313 (relating to eligibility for medical insurance</u>
- 12 <u>contributions</u>), the board shall receive contributions from the
- 13 <u>Commonwealth and fully pay the appropriate charges to the</u>
- 14 insurance carrier. QUALIFIED UNDER SECTION 8313 (RELATING TO
- 15 ELIGIBILITY FOR MEDICAL INSURANCE CONTRIBUTIONS) AND HAS ELECTED
- 16 MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL AND HOSPITALIZATION INSURANCE COVERAGE,
- 17 THE BOARD SHALL RECEIVE CONTRIBUTIONS FROM THE COMMONWEALTH AND
- 18 PAY THE APPROPRIATE ANNUAL CHARGES FOR SUCH COVERAGE ON BEHALF
- 19 OF THE ANNUITANT.

- 21 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 1987, or
- 22 immediately, whichever is later.
