10	(c) Limitations on nonstate serviceCreditable nonstate
11	service credit shall be limited to:
12	(1) intervening military service;
13	(2) other military service not exceeding five years;
14	(3) service in any public school or public educational
15	institution in any state other than this Commonwealth or in
16	any territory or area under the jurisdiction of the United
17	States; or service as an administrator, <u>manager,</u> teacher, or
18	instructor in the field of education for any agency or

1 department of the government of the United States, whether or 2 not such area was under the jurisdiction of the United 3 States, the total of such service not exceeding the lesser of 4 ten years or the number of years of active membership in the 5 system, as an officer or employee of the Department of Education or as an administrator, teacher, or instructor 6 7 employed in any State-owned educational institution or The 8 Pennsylvania State University; or

9 (4) previous service with a governmental agency other 10 than the Commonwealth which employment with said agency was 11 terminated because of the transfer by statute of the 12 administration of such service or of the entire agency to the 13 Commonwealth.

15 Section 2. Section 5505 of Title 71 is amended by adding a 16 subsection to read:

17 § 5505. Contributions for the purchase of credit for

18 creditable nonstate service.

20 (f) Purchase of manager service. -- Contributions on account

21 of credit for service as a manager under section 5304(c)(3)

22 (relating to creditable nonstate service) shall be equal to the

23 present value of the full actuarial cost of the increase in the

24 projected superannuation annuity caused by the additional

25 service credited. The amount contributed under this subsection

26 shall not be payable as a lump sum under section 5705(a)(4)(iii)

27 (relating to member's options).

28 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
