AN ACT

Amending the act of July 18, 1974 (P.L.483, No.174), entitled 2 "An act authorizing the Pennsylvania Higher Education 3 Assistance Agency to make institutional assistance grants on behalf of Pennsylvania State scholarship students attending independent institutions of higher education in the 5 Commonwealth, and making an appropriation, "further providing 6 7 for the definition of "eligible institution." 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The definition of "eligible institution" in section 3 of the act of July 18, 1974 (P.L.483, No.174), known 11 12 as The Institutional Assistance Grants Act, is amended to read: 13 Section 3. Definitions. -- As used in this act: 14 "Eligible institution" shall mean an independent institution 15 16 of higher education located in and chartered by[,] the Commonwealth, including a hospital operating a school of nursing 17

- 2 State-owned institution, State-related institution nor a
- 3 community college, which is operated not for profit, which is
- 4 determined by the agency not to be a theological seminary or
- 5 school of theology or a sectarian and denominational institution
- 6 and which is approved by the agency for assistance grants
- 7 pursuant to the provisions of this act.
