- 12 (b) Acts which may impose liability. -- The following acts by
- 13 a Commonwealth party may result in the imposition of liability
- 14 on the Commonwealth and the defense of sovereign immunity shall
- 15 not be raised to claims for damages caused by:

- 17 (4) Commonwealth real estate, highways and sidewalks.--

1	(i) A dangerous condition of Commonwealth agency
2	real estate and sidewalks, including Commonwealth-owned
3	real property, leaseholds in the possession of a
4	Commonwealth agency and Commonwealth-owned real property
5	leased by a Commonwealth agency to private persons, and
6	highways under the jurisdiction of a Commonwealth agency
7	except conditions described in paragraph (5).

(ii) Liability under this paragraph shall include, but shall not be limited to, damages for soil erosion and other storm water-related damage to private lands caused by the permanent diversion, alteration or modification of storm water courses in connection with a State highway construction or renovation project.
