AN ACT

1 Designating January 30, Franklin Delano Roosevelt's birthday, as
2 "Day of the Disabled."

3 WHEREAS, Over 1,000,000 citizens of this Commonwealth are
4 considered to be physically disabled; and

5 WHEREAS, Through courage and determination, the physically
6 disabled have conquered seemingly insurmountable obstacles to
7 lead successful lives; and

8 WHEREAS, The physically disabled demonstrate unique character
9 and perseverance in pursuing and attaining their desired goals;
10 and

11 WHEREAS, These individuals have made noteworthy contributions
12 to their communities, this Commonwealth and the nation; and

13 WHEREAS, The physically disabled of this Commonwealth deserve

1 the recognition of this Commonwealth and its citizens.

2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
3 hereby enacts as follows:

4 Section 1. Day of the disabled.

5 In honor of the birthday of one of America's most
6 distinguished physically disabled individuals, Franklin Delano
7 Roosevelt, January 30 of each year is hereby designated as "Day
8 of the Disabled," in recognition and in honor of the disabled
9 citizens of Pennsylvania.

10 Section 2. Effective date.

11 This act shall take effect immediately.
