AN ACT

1 Amending Title 24 (Education) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for return to school service
3 during emergencies.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 8346(b) of Title 24 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 8346. Termination of annuities.

10 (b) Return to school service during emergency.--When, in the
11 judgment of the employer, an emergency creates an increase in
12 the work load such that there is serious impairment of service
13 to the public or in the event of a shortage of appropriate
14 subject certified teachers, an annuitant may be returned to
15 school service for a period not to exceed [75 days] ~~120~~ 95 full- <—
16 day sessions in any school year without loss of his annuity.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
