AN ACT

- 1 Authorizing the City of Scranton, Lackawanna County, to sell and
- 2 convey certain Project 70 lands free of Project 70
- 3 restrictions for a housing development, in return for use of
- 4 the sale proceeds to purchase land along the Lackawanna
- 5 River.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Authorization.
- 9 Pursuant to the requirements of section 20(b) of the act of
- 10 June 22, 1964 (Sp.Sess., P.L.131, No.8), known as the Project 70
- 11 Land Acquisition and Borrowing Act, the General Assembly hereby
- 12 authorizes the sale of the lands described in section 2 and the
- 13 release of the restrictions imposed by section 20 of the Project
- 14 70 Land Acquisition and Borrowing Act from lands owned by the
- 15 City of Scranton, Lackawanna County, and more particularly
- 16 described in section 2, in exchange for the use of the proceeds
- 17 from the sale of said lands described in section 2 to purchase
- 18 lands along the Lackawanna River within the City of Scranton.
- 19 Section 2. Land to be sold free from restrictions.

- 1 The parcel of land authorized to be sold and released from
- 2 restrictions is more particularly described as follows:
- 3 Beginning at an iron pin corner in the northeasterly sideline
- 4 of Eynon Street, said beginning corner being in the division
- 5 line between city assessment lot number 32 and lot number 47 in
- 6 city assessment block number 8 in the 15th ward; thence, north
- 7 42 degrees east along the said division line between lots number
- 8 32 and 47 for a distance of 117 feet to an iron pin corner, said
- 9 last mentioned iron pin corner being located 16 feet
- 10 southwesterly along said division line between said lots from
- 11 the southwesterly sideline of Hand Place; thence, through, over
- 12 and across the rear portions of lots fronting on said Eynon
- 13 Street south 47 degrees 45 minutes east for a distance of 455.13
- 14 feet to an iron pin corner, said last mentioned line being
- 15 located 16 feet southwesterly from the parallel with the said
- 16 southwesterly sideline of Hand Place; thence, along a curve to
- 17 the right whose radius is 30 feet and its length of arc being
- 18 46.99 feet and its chord being along a line bearing south 02
- 19 degrees 52 1/2 minutes east for a distance of 42.33 feet to an
- 20 iron pin corner; thence, south 42 degrees west for a distance of
- 21 371 feet to an iron pin corner, said last mentioned line being
- 22 located 10 feet northwesterly from and parallel with the
- 23 northwesterly sideline of South Sixth Avenue, said last
- 24 mentioned line also crosses parts of lots along said South Sixth
- 25 Avenue, Eynon Street and Regan Place; thence, along a curve to
- 26 the right whose radius is 30 feet and its length of arc being
- 27 47.25 feet and its chord being along a line bearing south 87
- 28 degrees 07 1/2 minutes west for a distance of 42.52 feet to an
- 29 iron pin corner; thence, through, over and across the front
- 30 portions of lots fronting on West Elm Street, north 47 degrees

- 1 45 minutes west for a distance of 353 feet to an iron pin
- 2 corner, said last mentioned line being located 10 feet
- 3 northeasterly from and parallel with the said northeasterly
- 4 sideline of West Elm Street; thence, along a curve to the right
- 5 whose radius is 30 feet and its length of arc being 46.99 feet
- 6 and its chord being along a line bearing north 02 degrees 52 1/2
- 7 minutes west for a distance of 42.33 feet to an iron pin corner;
- 8 thence, north 42 degrees east for a distance of 284.13 feet to
- 9 an iron pin corner in the first mentioned northeasterly sideline
- 10 of Eynon Street; thence, north 47 degrees 45 minutes west along
- 11 said northeasterly sideline of Eynon Street for a distance of 72
- 12 feet to a corner, the place of beginning.
- 13 Containing 4.27 acres, more or less.
- 14 Comprising all of city assessment lots numbered 27B and 28B
- 15 in city assessment block number 42 in the 15th ward and portions
- 16 of city assessment lots numbered 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24,
- 17 25A, 25B, 26A, 26B, 27A, 27C and 28A in city assessment block
- 18 number 42 in the 15th ward. Also portions of city assessment
- 19 lots numbered 1, 1A, 8 and all of city assessment lots numbered
- 20 2A, 2B, 3, 4, 4A, 5, 6 and 7 in city assessment block number 7
- 21 in the 15th ward, and also portions of city assessment lots
- 22 numbered 32, 33, 48, 34, 35A, 35B, 36, 49, 37, 38, 39, 40 and
- 23 40A in city assessment block number 8 in the 15th ward, also a
- 24 413 foot portion of both Eynon Street and Regan Place abutting
- 25 the said lots, which are to be vacated.
- 26 Bearings of the above description are as the magnetic needle
- 27 pointed in March 1966.
- 28 Subject to two utility easements, being that portion of Eynon
- 29 Street, 413 feet in length by 40 feet in width and also that
- 30 portion of Regan Place, 413 feet in length by 15 feet in width,

- 1 inclusive of two portions of land 413 feet in length by 2.5 feet
- 2 in width abutting both the northeasterly and southwesterly
- 3 sidelines of said Regan Place.
- 4 Section 3. Restriction of revenue.
- 5 The proceeds from the sale of the lands described in section
- 6 2, or an amount of \$50,000, whichever is greater, shall be
- 7 deposited in a special interest-bearing account established by
- 8 the City of Scranton. The special account shall be used to
- 9 purchase lands within the City of Scranton along the Lackawanna
- 10 River for the same purposes as defined in the act of June 22,
- 11 1964 (Sp.Sess., P.L.131, No.8), known as the Project 70 Land
- 12 Acquisition and Borrowing Act. No funds shall be dispensed from
- 13 the special account without approval by the Department of
- 14 Community Affairs. Any funds remaining in the special account
- 15 after five years from the effective date of this act shall be
- 16 paid to the Commonwealth for deposit into the Project 70 Land
- 17 Acquisition Sinking Fund.
- 18 Section 4. Description of deed restrictions.
- 19 The lands acquired pursuant to this act along the Lackawanna
- 20 River by the City of Scranton shall include a deed restriction
- 21 as follows:
- This indenture is to provide land for recreation,
- 23 conservation and historical purposes, as said purposes are
- 24 defined in the act of June 22, 1964 (Sp.Sess., P.L.131,
- No.8), known as the Project 70 Land Acquisition and Borrowing
- 26 Act.
- 27 Section 5. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect immediately.
