AN ACT

- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section SECTIONS to read:
- 8 § 1348. Vietnam veteran plates.
- 9 On the application of any person who was a Vietnam veteran,
- 10 as determined by the Veterans' Administration, the department
- 11 shall issue a special registration plate designating the vehicle
- 12 <u>as belonging to a Vietnam veteran. The registration plate shall</u>
- 13 have a white background, shall have red numbers or letters as
- 14 the department may determine, shall have the outline of the

- 1 entire country of Vietnam in red, and shall have the words
- 2 <u>"Vietnam Veteran," in at least 10-point boldface type, inscribed</u>
- 3 <u>in red at the bottom of the plate. Only one special registration</u>
- 4 plate shall be issued to a Vietnam veteran under this section.
- 5 It may be used only on one passenger vehicle or one other
- 6 <u>vehicle with a registered gross weight of not more than 9,000</u>
- 7 pounds.
- 8 § 1931.2. VIETNAM VETERAN REGISTRATION PLATE.
- 9 THE FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A VIETNAM VETERAN REGISTRATION
- 10 PLATE SHALL BE \$20 WHICH SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL
- 11 REGISTRATION FEE. ONLY ONE PAYMENT OF THE ISSUANCE FEE SHALL BE
- 12 CHARGED FOR EACH VIETNAM VETERAN REGISTRATION ISSUED OR
- 13 REPLACED.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
