AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), entitled, as  
2 reenacted, "An act relating to alcoholic liquors, alcohol and  
3 malt and brewed beverages; amending, revising, consolidating  
4 and changing the laws relating thereto; regulating and  
5 restricting the manufacture, purchase, sale, possession,  
6 consumption, importation, transportation, furnishing, holding  
7 in bond, holding in storage, traffic in and use of alcoholic  
8 liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the  
9 persons engaged or employed therein; defining the powers and  
10 duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing  
11 for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores,  
12 for the payment of certain license fees to the respective  
13 municipalities and townships, for the abatement of certain  
14 nuisances and, in certain cases, for search and seizure  
15 without warrant; prescribing penalties and forfeitures;  
16 providing for local option, and repealing existing laws,"  
17 removing certain restrictions on members of the board and  
18 certain employees of the Commonwealth.

19 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
20 hereby enacts as follows:

21 Section 1. Section 210(a) of the act of April 12, 1951  
22 (P.L.90, No.21), known as the Liquor Code, reenacted and amended  
23 June 29, 1987 (P.L.32, No.14), is amended to read:

24 Section 210. Restrictions on Members of the Board and  
25 Certain Employees of Commonwealth.--(a) A member or employe of

1 the board or enforcement bureau [or a member of the immediate  
2 family of a member or employe of the board or enforcement  
3 bureau] shall not be directly or indirectly interested or  
4 engaged in any other business or undertaking dealing in liquor,  
5 alcohol, or malt or brewed beverages, whether as owner, part  
6 owner, partner, member of syndicate, shareholder, agent or  
7 employe, and whether for his own benefit or in a fiduciary  
8 capacity for some other person.

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
