A RESOLUTION

- 1 Memorializing the Governor to proclaim June 20, 1987, as
 2 "Pennsylvania Jugglers' Day."
- 3 WHEREAS, Forty years ago, on June 20, 1947, eight jugglers
- 4 gathered in a restaurant in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania and founded
- 5 the International Jugglers Association; and
- 6 WHEREAS, One of our fellow members, the Honorable Edwin G.
- 7 Johnson was one of the founders and charter members of the
- 8 association; and
- 9 WHEREAS, That group of eight members, most of whom were from
- 10 Pennsylvania has now grown to 2,760, with members in all of the
- 11 continents of the world; and
- 12 WHEREAS, In celebration of the 40th anniversary of the
- 13 founding of their organization, on June 20, 1987, juggling clubs
- 14 throughout the United States are sponsoring a special "learn to
- 15 juggle day, " with free instructions, so that more of our
- 16 citizens may enjoy the good exercise, companionship and fun
- 17 which juggling provides; therefore be it

- 1 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives memorialize the
- 2 Governor to proclaim June 20, 1987, as "Pennsylvania Jugglers'
- 3 Day, " in recognition of the 40th anniversary of the founding of
- 4 the International Jugglers Association; and be if further
- 5 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
- 6 the Honorable Robert P. Casey, Governor of Pennsylvania.
