A RESOLUTION

Memorializing Congress to pass legislation which requires the 2 Secretary of Defense to implement actions to appoint military 3 chaplains in representative proportion to the different faiths represented among the total membership of the armed 5 forces. 6 WHEREAS, The Secretary of Defense has been empowered traditionally to provide for the religious and spiritual needs of members of the armed forces by appointing military chaplains; 9 and 10 WHEREAS, There exists an imbalance in the representation of 11 various religious faiths among chaplains of the armed forces as compared to the representation of those faiths among members of 12 13 the armed forces as a whole; and 14 WHEREAS, This body is concerned that the men and women from 15 this Commonwealth who serve with commitment and gallantry in the 16 armed forces of this Nation should have the religious and 17 spiritual needs which arise during the course of their military

service served by a chaplain of their faith; therefore be it
