## A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the month of October as "Pennsylvania Housing
- 2 Month."
- 3 WHEREAS, Shelter is one of the basic needs for all
- 4 individuals, and the production and marketing of affordable
- 5 housing are important concerns at all levels of government; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The opportunity to own a home constitutes the
- 7 American dream and strengthens our families and communities; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The housing industry has a significant impact on
- 9 Pennsylvania's economy by creating employment opportunities for
- 10 its people, stimulating the need for additional goods and
- 11 services, and contributing millions of dollars of tax revenues
- 12 to local, State and national treasuries; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The housing industry offers free training for the
- 14 unemployed and the disadvantaged and gives to these
- 15 Pennsylvanians a sense of pride and usefulness, while offering
- 16 the opportunity for a new beginning; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The combined commitment of State government with the

- 1 strength and ingenuity of the private sector housing industry
- 2 has brought safe and decent housing to a majority of
- 3 Pennsylvanians; and
- 4 WHEREAS, It is appropriate to reaffirm the State's commitment
- 5 to decent and affordable housing for all our citizens and for
- 6 those Pennsylvanians who have not yet obtained homeownership and
- 7 to recognize the economic opportunities created by the housing
- 8 industry; therefore be it
- 9 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
- 10 designate the month of October as "Pennsylvania Housing Month";
- 11 and be it further
- 12 RESOLVED, That the Governor be requested to issue a
- 13 proclamation calling upon the people of the Commonwealth of
- 14 Pennsylvania to observe that month with appropriate ceremonies
- 15 and activities.
