A RESOLUTION

1 Memorializing the Governor to take steps to abolish the
2 Catastrophic Loss Trust Fund and to propose and endorse a
3 program which would make participation in catastrophic
4 insurance optional on individual automobile policies.

5 WHEREAS, Announcement by the Catastrophic Loss Trust Fund
6 Board that it has voted to triple the CAT Fund fee for vehicle
7 owners of this Commonwealth has caused serious concern among
8 millions of citizens of this Commonwealth; and

9 WHEREAS, It has been estimated that even the aforesaid
10 increase will not be sufficient to adequately fund the program;
11 therefore be it

12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives memorialize the
13 Governor to take steps to abolish that Catastrophic Loss Trust
14 Fund and to propose and endorse a program which would make
15 participation in catastrophic insurance optional on individual
16 automobile policies.
