- 2 WHEREAS, Irving Berlin will celebrate his 100th birthday
- 3 anniversary on May 11, 1988; and

2 Pennsylvanians and all Americans as the composer of hundreds of
3 songs, many of which have become part of our American Heritage;

5 WHEREAS, Irving Berlin personifies the American dream of the
6 poor immigrant who arrived on these shores and made good; and

7 WHEREAS, Pennsylvanians, along with all Americans, wish to
8 honor Irving Berlin on his 100th birthday anniversary; therefore
