A RESOLUTION

1 Directing the House Transportation Committee to investigate
2 expansion of the mass transportation system in Allegheny
3 County.

4 WHEREAS, The Pittsburgh Region has undergone a significant
5 economic transformation; and

6 WHEREAS, The traditional closeness between the place of an
7 employment and an individual's residence has been disrupted by
8 the economic changes; and

9 WHEREAS, The location of job opportunities within the region
10 are becoming increasingly diverse, particularly as the airport
11 area develops; and

12 WHEREAS, The public transportation is a critical element in
13 connecting regional opportunities; and

14 WHEREAS, The Port Authority, because of lack of funding, has
15 indicated that it will be at least 12 years before additional
16 major expansion of mass transportation routes can take place in
17 the region; therefore be it

18 RESOLVED, That the House Transportation Committee be directed

1 to investigate that financial, right-of-way and technological
2 impediments exist that would cause such a delay in any
3 expansion; and be it further

4 RESOLVED, That the House Transportation Committee make
5 recommendations to the House of Representatives as to how the
6 expansion of the mass transportation system in Allegheny County
7 can be accelerated.
